The project uses design techniques focusing on the development of an educational platform that will stimulate the project's target groups in civic engagement, learning and collaboration to improve engagement levels. To this end, a platform for Academic Deliberative Arenas was created to encourage the engagement of academic and local communities.

For the finalization of the platform, **Pilot Actions** took place in all participating countries. In addition, **7 Multiplier Events** will be organised by the end of the project, one in each country, to present and promote the TENACITY's results.

Pilot actions

Pilot actions were carried out in 7 different countries to demonstrate and test the TENACITY platform:

Partners involved the academic community (students, researchers, professors, academic staff, etc), as well as associated partners at the national and international levels, and a wide range of stakeholders from local communities, including regional authorities and decision-makers who played an active role in the pilot actions and testing of the tools.

The digital platform and its tools were tested, by a total of **at least 400 users**, who evaluated its content and functionality and provided feedback on its development and finalisation.

More specifically, each partner organised several national and regional events to present the platform and the set of tools and involved universities, the local community and other stakeholders in the project.











These events will be organized in **7 participating countries** by the end of the project for presenting the TENACITY project and sharing the project results.

The participation of international, national and regional stakeholders (representatives of students, professors, researchers, academic managers, policymakers, guidance practitioners, researchers in the education field) is foreseen for each event.

Each country will organise and promote the event at national level, with the participation of national stakeholders and professional community of teachers.

The **main objectives** of this event is to involve universities, policymakers and other stakeholders in the exploitation of the to collect feedback on the results of the project to improve its overall quality.





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
